



## Announcing the MDPQC Hospital Recognition Program

As we approach the conclusion of the current MDPQC initiatives, we want to recognize you for your hard work. Since 2021, the MDPQC has hosted 37 office hour calls, 12 learning events, and collected 8 quarters/20 months of data across the hypertension and antibiotic stewardship initiatives. To show our appreciation for your participation and commitment to improving health outcomes for women and newborns, we are preparing digital badges that your hospital will be able to display on your website, along with a plaque to acknowledge your work.

Hospitals will be eligible for one of three different levels of recognition, depending on your participation in the Collaborative initiatives (hospitals participating in both initiatives will receive 2 awards):

- **Silver-Level Participants:** Joined initiative, submitted ANY data.
- **Gold-Level Participants:** Submitted at least 75% of data between Q1-2022 and Q1-2023, AND attended at least two office hours events during that time.
- **Platinum-Level Participants:** Submitted 100% of data between Q1-2022 and Q1-2023, AND attended at least half of the office hours events during that time.

We will begin evaluating data following the April 30th submission deadline for the Q1-2023 data, so there is still time to move up in participation levels!
